04/02047/FUL Old Coach House, Court Row – alterations/extensions to existing semi-derelict building to provide 2 self contained flats – no objection if control applied to building materials

04/01971/LBC The Swan, Waterside – removal of external painted finishes to masonry, insertion of Helix stitches, replacement of roof tiles, lead to porch. Rebuilding of masonry structures to The Barn and introduction of structural wall ties to The Barn – elevation drawings and supporting letter not attached to application therefore the Committee could not comment.

04/02039/FUL - Builders Yard, Prices Lane – conversion of office to dwelling and construction of 2 bungalows - no objection but planning conditions should be applied to ensure that the road is resurfaced satisfactorily after building works and that the driveways have adequate visibility to the highway.
