

Upton YFC Triumph at Competitions Day!

Saturday 29th May was an incredible and historical day for Upton-Upon-Severn YFC. The Worcestershire Federation of Young Farmers' Clubs Annual Competitions Day was held locally in Baughton. Upton took part in 58 competitions, competing against eight other clubs in the county. Competitions such as Morris dancing, cake decorating, metalwork, tractor handling and cookery were completed by many of Upton's 46 members who are aged between 14 and 26 years.

Members were ecstatic when it was announced that Upton YFC had won the entire day by over 400 points! This is the first time in 62 years of competing in the competition that Upton have won; the atmosphere was truly electric and opponent clubs joined in congratulating Upton on their remarkable success. A triple victory: not only did the club win the prestigious Championship Cup, they were also the overall winners of the Stock judging and Junior Member trophies.

The evening concluded with a disco to celebrate the days achievements.

Upton YFC will now represent Worcestershire in a number of competitions at the Three Counties Show. They will be competing against clubs from Herefordshire and Gloucestershire.
